
## 1. Configuring Windows

#### 1.1 Opening Credential Manager in Windows


#### STEP 1

Click [Start] → [Control Panel].



## STEP 2

Select [User Accounts and Family Safety].



### STEP 3

#### Select [User Accounts].



#### STEP 4


#### Select [Manage your credentials].



#### 1.2 Remove credentials

#### STEP 1

Select the Windows Credentials that you want to remove. (In the example below, 172.16.4.101 is the credential for our NAS).



## STEP 2

Click [Remove from vault] to delete the credential.
