### Installation Notes

- ASUSTOR recommends taking regular backups regardless of whether you upgrade ADM or not.
- After upgrading to ADM 3.1, it will no longer be possible to revert back to an older version.
- After upgrading to ADM 3.1, please update all NAS apps and mobile apps to minimize compatibility issues.



### What's New?

- SSD Caching
  - Support 1~4 SSDs
  - Supports Read-only mode in RAID 0 and Read-Write mode in RAID 1,5 and 10
  - Supported Models: AS31/32/50/51/61/62/63/64/70 series.
- LDAP Client
  - Can now synchronize with LDAP Servers.
  - Support added for Samba, AFTP, FTP, ADM login.
- RAID Scrubbing
  - Now supports RAID 5 and RAID 6.
